


## Human Anatomy 4 Information Pieces

<b>Trachea</b> HA-4	<b>Pharynx</b> HA-4
Takes air to the lungs HA-4	<b>Throat</b> HA-4
<b>Bronchus</b> HA-4	<b>Epiglottis</b> HA-4
Air passages to the lungs HA-4	Flap to prevent food from going into the trachea HA-4
<b>Bronchiole</b> HA-4	<b>Pleural Space</b> HA-4
Smaller air passages HA-4	Small fluid filled lining around the lung HA-4
<b>Alveoli (air sac)</b> HA-4	<b>Diaphragm</b> HA-4
Releases oxygen into the blood and removes carbon dioxide from the blood HA-4	Muscle that expands the lung and causes air to go into the lung HA-4
