




Less than 8 inches of precipitation
Few plants which require very little water



6-10 inches precipitation
No trees, plants withstand wind and cold
Seems wetter because the precipitation that falls evaporates slowly in cold weather.



10-20 inches precipitation
Flat land with lots of grass



15 to 40 inches
High altitude has lower temperature and more rain than nearby lowlands. Windy with few large plants.






25 to 50 inches of precipitation
